

CURRICULUM

PRE MEDICAL PROGRAM

A dedicated faculty, caring and encouraging counselors, an enriching community, all wrapped up in a beautiful and vibrant environment, is what awaits our high school finishers (12th graders) at the American University of Barbados for the Pre Medical program. The program consists of 4 semesters. The subjects taught during this phase strengthen our medical student's foundational knowledge.

BASIC SCIENCE PROGRAM

The Basic Science program is of 5 semesters and comprises of Pre-clinical and Paraclinical subjects. The problem-based teaching methodology at AUB provides students with extensive USMLE training throughout the Basic Science program. In order to succeed in USMLE and practice in USA, students are encouraged to take NBME exams, which are practice exams and approximates the USMLE standards. The students save time as the MD program and USMLE preparation goes hand in hand. Such rigorous training helps students to score better in USMLE in their first attempt.

CLINICAL SCIENCE PROGRAM

The Clinical Science Program comprises of intensive 72 weeks of physiciansupervised clinical training. This includes 48 weeks of Core Rotations and 24 weeks of Elective Rotations at our teaching affiliate hospitals and specialized clinical facilities in USA and other countries. Students receive personal guidance from the clinical faculty to develop essential skills and knowledge. We encourage students to take the NBME examination after every core rotation, which in turn prepares them for the USMLE Step 2.

These electives are tailored to help and guide students into specific residencies. INNOVATIVE TEACHING METHODOLOGY

Our advanced teaching methods include Medical Simulation Games, 3D Medical Animation and Educational Softwares which have been developed in collaboration with our associate concern Era's Lucknow Medical College and Hospital in India.

INTEGRATED CURRICULUM

AUB students follow a well planned, innovative and integrated curriculum, which makes interdisciplinary connections more effective, thereby enhancing the learning process. It breaks down learning impediments and stimulates student focus leading to progress. The 'Layered Learning' process in addition to the balanced curriculum combines different disciplines, encourages and facilitates critical thinking as opposed to learning distinctive and isolated topics of medicine.

3D MEDICAL ANIMATION

Our easy-to-access 3D medical animations simplify complex topics in medicine, clarifying concepts and thereby making them more fascinating and stimulating for students. The animations deliver a rich experience by visually depicting functional and dynamic mechanisms of the human body. It explains more in less time and depicts the intricacies of medical science that cannot be replicated by a 2D illustration, diagram, photograph or even live action.

MEDICO SKILLS

Medico Skills is AUB's computer-based evaluation system which reinforces our focus on competency-based medical education. It helps students assess and improve their clinical skills in their own time.



3D ANATOMY MODELS AND MANIKINS

It develops an environment of kinesthetic learning from the early years of a student's medical career. Most of our manikins are integrated with the medical video games thereby students get scored for their performance.

MEDICAL SIMULATION GAMES

AUB students have access to medical video games based on medical problems and their management. The games develop the players acquired reflexes to manage patients in real life situations. The activities range from basic clinical evaluation to emergency management and surgical procedures.


COMPUTER AIDED REVISION AND EVALUATION (CARE)

CARE is an app-based platform to help AUB students revise their attended lessons in an interactive manner. This helps to shift the learned information to the long-term memory of the students on a daily basis.









AUB ADDS ANATOMAGE TABLE FOR DIGITAL CADAVER EXPERIENCE

The Anatomage Table (also referred to as Virtual Cadaver Table Anatomage) is the most technologically advanced digital visualization system for anatomy education. The cadavers created by Anatomage are identical to real cadavers, and the ultrahigh quality (UHQ) visualizations deliver photorealistic anatomical structures in accurate 3D. This fully interactive, life-sized touchscreen experience allows for exploration and learning of human anatomy beyond what any cadaver could provide, resulting in improved conceptual and spatial comprehension of the human body.



RESEARCH

The School of Medicine is committed to medical excellence and encourages students to be actively involved in research and publications. The school also honors young researchers with awards and recognitions. Era's Lucknow Medical College and Hospital, an associate concern of AUB publishes Era's Journal of Medical Research (EJMR) in collaboration with American University of Barbados, which is indexed and peer reviewed. This journal publishes original research work and recent medical updates covering various specialties and subspecialties to enhance and upgrade the research work. It also helps to promote the interaction between the academician and researcher nationally and internationally. Our focus areas are *Cancer Cell Therapy, Brain & Spinal Cord Injury, Neuro Degenerative Diseases, Lifestyle Medicine and Personalized Medicine.*





ON-CAMPUS COMMUNITY CLINIC

Considering it as a social and moral responsibility to serve the Barbadian community, the American University of Barbados is operating a community clinic on its campus at Wildey. The medical clinic provides free consultation to all seeking medical advice and is the first of its kind initiative to be taken by any medical school in the Carribean.

The on-campus medical clinic also renders early clinical exposure to our students. From the start of the MD program, AUB students participate in observership at the clinic, they have sessions with medical doctors as well as nursing practitioners that refines their communication skills. Students also get an opportunity to take patient history under supervision which is followed by case discussion that helps them in correlating the symptoms with the disease. They learn to work as a team and master the art of communication with the patients, their relatives, colleagues and paramedical staff.

The medical school in future also intends to provide laboratory and radiology services and is in the process of procuring the necessary permissions and approvals. Furthermore, AUB plans to establish a Lead Screening Center for the early detection and prompt management of lead toxicity which is becoming a global menace. With an aim to strengthen health and wellness AUB aspires to build the foundation for healthcare in the country.

IN TIMES OF COVID-19

AUB had prepared well in advance to deal with the COVID-19 pandemic. Students were timely informed so that they could return home and be safe with their families. Those who chose to stay back were taken care of by our staff. They were provided take-away meals by the cafeteria and essential supplies were delivered on-campus for them. The medical doctors from our on-campus clinic were also available for students and faculty who needed consultation and treatment.

Arrangements were made to ensure that the studies of our students were not affected. Preclinical teaching was carried out using both the Zoom and Moodle platforms. With a student body spanning over more than 24 countries in different time zones, the lessons taught were recorded and posted on Moodle for easy student reference. Examinations were conducted phase wise via Exam Soft Remote Proctoring System for which our staff obtained the necessary training.

In keeping with its innovative trend AUB in collaboration with its associate concern Era's Lucknow Medical College, developed the DIGI DOCTOR App for tele-consultation.









Innovative Health care initiatives taken by AUB in collaboration with Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, India.

"We learn more in crisis than in comfort"

This user friendly app provided the much needed respite to the Barbadian community during this time of need. The VR-SECURE BOOTH for examination and sample collection of COVID-19 suspected patients and a negative pressure resuscitation bed were also fabricated. Keeping in mind the contagious nature of COVID-19 a Remote Monitoring Dashboard was developed for continuous monitoring of patients at the same time minimizing exposure to the healthcare workers. Our research team used molecular docking technique for identifying compounds effective against the viral proteins in green tea, chamomile tea, turmeric and parsley and Evidence-Based Diet was formulated for targeting inflammation and cytokine storm in COVID-19 patients.

AUB applauds the courage and dedication of all the healthcare workers around the globe in the face of this adversity. Being a School of Medicine our responsibility in this hour of need is even greater and we resolve to work tirelessly for the benefit of humanity.





ACCOMMODATION AND CAMPUS FACILITIES

The use of 3D animation lets us visualize complex processes which helps us understand and remember things more effectively. Also, the hands-on training on the video games which are based on medical problems and procedures develops our thinking and decision-making skills. VISA INFORMATION

ENTRY VISA (valid for 3 months only)

All visitors to Barbados whether tourists or parents/guardians of students require a valid passport, entry visa and return tickets to the country of their residence. Also information regarding the address of stay in Barbados should be disclosed. Individuals under the age of eighteen traveling without a parent/guardian must have a letter of authorization from the parent/guardian. However the nationals of CARICOM, UK, USA, India and some commonwealth countries do not require an entry visa, they may travel to Barbados with their valid passport and the visa will be stamped on arrival.

STUDENT VISA

All non-immigrant students including nationals of CARICOM, UK, USA and India etc. are required to have a STUDENT VISA in order to study at the American University of Barbados, School of Medicine. Applications for student visa should be submitted on the prescribed form (FORM H1 & H2) to the immigration department before entering Barbados. AUB assists its students in the process of application and procurement of student visa for Barbados. For more details please visit Barbados immigration website, www.immigration.gov.bb

U.S. VISA INFORMATION

UK & Canadian nationals do not need a prior US visa, the visa will be stamped on arrival if the intended duration of stay in US is 90 days or less. In case the duration of stay is more than 90 days then a prior US visa will be required. Contrarily all students from other countries need to obtain a prior US visa if they wish to do their clinical training in USA and appear for USMLE Step 2 (CK) and Step 3. It is solely the responsibility of the student to obtain a US visa, though they receive all necessary help and guidance by the AUB officials.
